



Saving and Naming a Secondary Capture


Purpose

By default, the IntelliSpace Portal NM Viewer does not have the Save as... option when saving secondary captures in NM Viewer. This Quick Step outlines how to select the name given to the saved secondary capture.

Please keep in mind that this application has additional workflow steps and functionality, which is detailed in the Instructions for Use and is not intended to substitute or replace the *Instructions for Use*.

Workflow

To Save and Name Secondary Captures:



1. Load the appropriate data into the IntelliSpace Portal NM Viewer. The data can be dynamic, static, or whole body.
2. From the left navigation pane, click the (drop-down arrow) and select **Batch**.
3. Scroll to starting image then click **Start** under **Define Batch**.
4. Scroll through images to end point and click **End** under **Define Batch**.
5. Click the **Save** drop-down arrow and select **Save Batch as...**.
6. Name the batch.
7. Click the **File Format: DICOM** drop-down arrow and select one of the **Secondary Capture** options.
8. Select a **Destination**.
9. Click **Save**.
